

Minutes of Public Meeting.; held at Clydesdale Bank Chambers
Hamilton, on Thursday 26th May 1938 .

APPOINTMENT OF CHAIRMAN, Mr R. R. Sheresby-Harvie was appointed Chairman
and took the chair.

The Chairman intimated that this meeting had been called for the purpose of forming a Car Club. It was pointed out that there was an existing Club known as "Lanarkshire Motor Cycle and Car Club" of which he, Chairman was President; Mr Drew McQueen Vice president; Mr Watson Hon. Secretary, and Mr. W. Taylor Hon. Treasurer; that the said Club had been in existence since 1933; that while it was designated "The Lanarkshire Motor Cycle and Car Club" that there had never been a Motor car section of said Club; that the said Club has existed solely for motor cyclists and events connected with Motor cycling, and that it was not considered advisable to form a motor car section of the said Club.

It was further intimated that on 26 May 1938 at a General Meeting of the "Lanarkshire Motor Cycle and Car Club" it had been unanimously agreed to call this meeting for the purpose of forming a car section of the aforesaid Club. After a discussion it was agreed to form a car section of the Club, and it was unanimously agreed that while the members of the car section would also be members of the "Lanarkshire Motor Cycle and Car Club" the business of said car section would, be controlled independently of the motor cycle section; that the motor Car section would appoint its own office bearers, admit new members, collect subscriptions, make all financial arrangements and generally conduct all other business incidental to and connected with the control and management

It was further unanimously agreed that the only connection between the motor cycle section and motor car section of said Club would be with regard to social meeting outings and matters of general policy mutual to both sections of said Club.

With a view to having the mutual interests of the sections of the Club represented it was agreed that the President and Vice President of the motor cycle section would also be President and Vice President of the car section.

In view of the foregoing decisions as to the business of the motor car section of said Club being conducted independently of the interests of the motor cycle section of said Club, it was agreed to appoint Mr. J. G. Corke Hon. Secretary and Treasurer of the car section
